1) DEFINITIONS :-

In these Rules & Regulations, the followings words shall have the meanings assigned to them, unless repugnant to the subject of context namely:

1. The Institution. Shall mean the 'The Institution under Society Registration Act 1860 and Bombay public Trust Act 950.
2. The General Body shall mean the General Body of the Members of the Members of the 'Institution'.
3. The "council" shall mean Governing Council of the 'Foundation. 'Constituted and reconstituted under these rules.
4. The "president", "Secretary" & "Treasurer" shall mean the President and other officials of the Institution elected and/or appointed under these rules.
5. "Act" means and referred to in these shall mean the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 and Rules of 1951 framed hereunder.
6. "Committees" and "Sub Committees" means such committees and sub Committees constituted by the Governing Council for carrying out the schemes and objects of the 'Institution'.
7. Words imparting the singular number shall include the plural number and vice-versa and words imparting the masculine gender shall include the feminine gender and vice-versa.

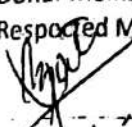
2) **JURISDICTION :-** The territorial jurisdiction of the Institution shall extend throughout MAHARASHTRA.

3) **ACCOUNTING YEAR :-** Accounting year is 1 April to 31 March.

4) **MEMBERSHIP :-** Admission to membership shall be subject to the sanction of the Governing Council of the Institution. Member must be completed age of 18 years. He /She must have knowledge of education field provided that Governing Council will not be bound to assign any reason for its decision in this behalf of rejecting membership.

- D) Donar Member

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- A) **Founder Member** :- The member who are found this Foundation. And they are Entitled to the Fee Rs. 101/-
- B) **Subscribed Member** :-The member who are subscribe. And they are entitled to the entrance fee Rs. 11/- and Annual fee 100/-
- C) **Permanent Member** :- The member who paid one time Rs. 5,000/- is known as permanent member.
- D) **Donar Member** :- The donar of The Foundation known as Donar Member.
- E) **Respected Member** :- The person reputed in various field are known as Respected Member.

6) **CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP** :-

- i) A member of the General Body of the Governing Council, or of any Committee or Sub Committee shall automatically cease to be a member of the Foundation on his / her i) Death
- ii) Being declared insolvent by a court of competent jurisdiction.
- iii) Being convicted of an offence, which in the opinion of the Council involves moral turpitude.
- iv) Becoming physically incapacitated and mentally incapable to work as a member,
- v) Being held by the Governing Council that he /she is unfit to continue as a member because of his/ her behaviour in a manner which is prejudicial to the interest or reputation of the Foundation.
- vi) Resignation being accepted by the President, provided that if his / her resignation is not duly accepted, he / she shall not be liable for any decision, act or in the part of the other members from the date of receipt of his registration by the President.
- vii) Being continuously absent without leave of absence from the Governing council absents from himself / herself in attending three consecutive Meetings.

7) **GENERAL BODY** :-

- **Composition** :- The General Body of the Foundation shall be composed of all the Members thereof. Provided that the members of the first Governing Council, mentioned in the Memorandum of Association shall be deemed to be the members of the Foundation and the General Body.
- **Rights and Duties** :- There shall be a meeting of the General Body at least once a year and as far as possible within six months after the expiry of the financial year. Additional meetings of the General Body may be held whenever necessary.

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- Function :-** The functions of the General Body shall be as under :- To consider the annual report about the working of the Foundation To take a note of the audited accounts of Foundation for the previous years and to offer remarks thereon, if any. To appoint auditor or auditors for auditing of the accounts of the Foundation for the ensuing year and to fix his / their remuneration. To consider any other subject as may be brought before the meeting with the permission of the presiding authority of that meeting. To elect every five years members in the Governing Council with the consent of the founder president.
- 8) **NOTICE OF MEETING AND QUORUM :-** Notice in writing stating the date, time and place of every meeting of the General Body together with an agenda thereof, shall be delivered by hand or send through certificate of posting to each member at his recorded addresses at least fifteen clear days before the meetings. Provided that in the case of urgent meeting, the notice period shall be seven clear days. The quorum for the meeting of General Body shall be three fifth of its total members. If no quorum is present within half an hour, after the time fixed for the meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned. The adjourned meeting may be held at any subsequent time on the same day if so notified in the original notice of the meeting or any other subsequent day as the President may decide. No quorum shall be necessary for an adjourned meeting.
- 9) **SPECIAL MEETING AND DUTIES :-** All decisions in the meetings of the General Body be taken by a simple majority or votes of the members present and voting on the preposition. Every member shall one vote but in the event of equality of votes, the President or the Chairman of the Meeting shall have a second or casting vote whether or not he/ she have previously voted on the proposition. Voting will carried out by 'POLL' method the General Body shall function not withstanding any defect in its constitution and no act or proceeding of the General Body shall be invalid by reason only any defect in its constitution or non-receipt of the notice of the meeting by any member which has been sent through post or otherwise.
- 10) **GOVERNING COUNCIL :-** The business and affairs of the Institutions shall be carried out by the Governing Council which may exercise all such powers and authorities of the Foundation as are allotted by any statute or under the Rules and Regulations not specifically required to be exercised by any other authority. The number of members of the Council shall not be less than Seven (7) and More than Eleventh(11). The members of the Governing Council shall be the Trustees. The Members of the Council shall hold office for a terms office years from the date of their appointment but they shall be eligible for reappointment. The terms of the office of the first Council shall be Five (5) years from the date of Registration of the Institution.

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11) **GOVERNING COUNCIL TIME LIMIT AND ELECTION PROCESS** :- The tenure of Governing council shall be of Five (5) years. The Governing council members shall be elected during the Annual General Meeting of the society. but the founder President and Secretary will be in permanent position till their life time and every five year Secretary will appoint members of the council Provided further that the member of the Council shall continue to hold office after the expiry of their term till the new Council is constituted and assumes office of the Council. Casual vacancies amongst the members of the Council occurring by any reason such as death, resignation, and removal, and removal of a member or otherwise shall be filled in by the Secretary and the Members co-opted or appointed shall hold office for the unexpired period of office of the member causing the Vacancy.


12) **OFFICIALS OF GOVERNING COUNCIL AND FUNCTIONS** :-
President, Secretary, Treasurer, & other members

a) **President** :-

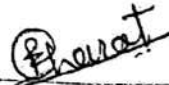
- To President over and conduct the general body meetings and the meetings of the Executive Committee.
- To operate bank account and be the bank signatory.
- To run and conduct the functions of the meeting.
- To gives orders in the interest of the society to control the day today work of society.

b) **Secretary** :-

- To call/arrange the meetings of the society.
- To look after correspondence of the society. to maintain truthful proceeding of all meeting of Executive Committee and General Body.
- To ward of the complaints. To take action in the interest of the society which helps to fulfils the aims & objectives of society.
- To make the rules and regulations for the day today work.
- They represent the society before any Court, Authority.
- To see the day financial transactions and to sign over it.
- To handle in cash of the society.
- To protect the property of the society.
- To execute the resolutions.
- To operate bank accounts and be the bank signatory. The signature of secretary will be must for all the transactions of bank account and to help for maintaining accounts.
- To submit the new proposals to government statutory bodies to start the new institutes as mentioned in aims & objectives of the society.

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- To take such action or to suggest such proposal which he deems fit and proper in the interest of the society & this fulfils the aims & objectives of society.
- To supervisor the administration of the organization and to keep control over the staff of the organization.
- To issue orders of appointment, removal, suspension for all the teaching, non-teaching, administrative staff and other staffs in all the institutes run by trust.
- To maintain or to get maintained the accounts of the society. To pass the bills of expenditure.
- To keep records of the society & set the proper procedure to store the records of the society.
- To do all over work, allotted, entrusted to him in the interest of the Society.
- To co-ordinate with all the institute heads and to maintain discipline in all the institutes / schools / colleges run by the society.
- To do compliance of statutory duties as provided under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, the Bombay Public Trust Acts 1950 & 1951, respectively or any other local or central laws as may be necessary for effectively managing and maintaining the Foundation.

c) **Treasurer :-**

He / she shall supervise the maintenance of Accounts of the accounts and its Committees / Sub- Committees. He / she shall get the said accounts balanced and audited through the authorized professionals auditors appointed by the General Body. He / she shall file the necessary accounts and returns with the concerned Government Authorities including the Charity Commissioner, the Income Tax Commissioner Etc. He / She shall make arrangements for the supervision and maintenance of Banking Accounts and Investments of funds as per statutory provisions, whenever necessary. He / she shall prepare the annual as per budget of the Organization and its Committees / Sub- Committees and place it before the Council for its consideration and approval. He / She shall pass bills for payment as per the directors of the Governing Council. Provided that this power can be delegated to some office bearer of Official subject to such conditions and restriction as the Governing Council may decide from time to time.

d) **Member :-**

He / She shall exercise such other powers and functions as may be assigned to him / her by the Governing Council.

- 13) **NOTICE AND QUORUM :-** Notice in writing stating the date, time and place of every meeting of the Council together with the agenda thereof shall be delivered by hand or sent through certificate of posting to each members at his recorded address at least seven clear days before the date before the date of the

meeting. Provided that in the case of urgent meeting, the notice period shall be three clear days. The quorum for the meetings of the Council shall be three fifth of its total members. Or four whichever is more. If no quorum is present within half an hour after the time fixed for the meeting, the meeting shall be adjourned. The adjourned meeting may be held at any subsequent time on the same day if so notified in the original of the meeting or any other subsequent day as the President may decide. No quorum shall be necessary for any adjourned meeting. All decisions in the meetings of the Council shall be taken by a simple majority of votes of the members present and voting on the proposition. Every member shall have one vote but in event of equality of votes, the President or Chairman of that meeting shall have a second or casting votes whether or not he / she have previously voted on the proposition. Any previous resolution of the Council may be rescinded or amended by the Council in its subsequent meeting held after three months. Such a decision can be taken earlier if it is supported by more than half of the total members in Council. Any matter of business of a routine, formal, formal or urgent nature may be determined by a circular to be issued by the Secretary without holding on a meeting of the Council, provided that any decision on such circular shall not be valid unless it is agreed to by more than three fifth of the total number of members of the Council. Such decisions shall be recorded in the minute's book subsequently in the next meeting of the Council. Presiding Authority: The President or in his absence the Secretary shall preside over the meetings of the Governing Council. If both of them happen to be absent in the meetings, the members present shall appoint one of them amongst themselves to be Chairman of that particular meeting.

- 14) **GOVERNING COUNCIL TIME LIMIT AND ELECTION PROCESS** :- Every five year annual General Body will appoint member of the council provided further that the member of the Council shall continue to hold office after the expiry of their term till new Council is constituted and assumes office of the Council. There shall be a meeting of the Council at least once in six months or at least two meetings in a year. Additional meetings may be held whenever necessary. The meetings will be convened by the Secretary in consultation with the President. If a written requisition signed by not less than three members of the council is made to the President for holding a special meeting of the Council, the President shall call such meeting within 15 days from the receipt of such requisition.
- 15) **VACANCY IN GOVERNING COUNCIL** :- Casual vacancies amongst the members of the Council occurring by any reason such as death, resignation, and removal of a member or otherwise shall be filled in by the president and the Members co-opted or appointed shall hold office for the unexpired period of office of the member causing the Vacancy.

Duties :- He must supervise all work of the Foundation and help the member of the managing committee and other help them in for Foundation

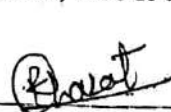
17) POWERS AND FUNCTION OF GOVERNING COUNCIL :- The rights, powers and functions of the Governing Council shall be as follows:

In furthestmost of the and without prejudice to the general powers conferred by or implied in these Rules and Regulations and / or in any other statutory provisions applicable to the Foundation, it is hereby expressly declared that the Council shall be entrusted with and shall have full power and authority to all acts, matters, things, and deeds which may be necessary for the promotion of the aims and objects of the Foundation, and for carrying on and managing day to day business and affairs of the Institute and all other ancillary and incidental things Without prejudice to the generally of the powers as conferred in clause - a above, the Council shall have inter alias and in particular the following powers. To look after, manage and supervise the management of the properties and funds of the foundation and to expend monies required for that purpose.

To acquire in the name of the Foundation by gift, purchases, exchange, lease, hire, license or otherwise however, any lands, buildings, easements or privileges for the purpose of the Foundation and to sell, assign, transfer, license, and otherwise dispose of any of the property of the Foundation. To build, construct and maintain houses and other buildings and to pull down, alter, extend, improve and repair any existing buildings and structures and of the Foundations. To construct, layout, extend, alter, extend, alter, enlarge, improve and use any land and / or other immovable property belonging to or held by the Foundation. To invite and collect funds by way of contributions, grants, donations, subscriptions, gifts, endowments, and the like from persons and institutions in India or from persons of Indian origin staying in foreign countries and from other Institutions abroad, subject to the laws in this behalf, with or without any conditions. Provided that any such conditions shall not be inconsistent with the basic structure and objects of the Institute or Trust. To raise or borrow any sum or sums or money with or without interest for purpose of the Foundation with or without security, if thought proper and to secure the payment of such manner and upon such terms and conditions in all respects as may determine from time to time subject to the provisions of 36A of the Bombay Public Trust, 1950. Subject to the provisions of section 35 of the Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950 as to those

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of the Income Tax Act, 1961, to invest surplus funds not the Foundation not needed for immediate utilization, in authorized investments and to sell, vary or transpose such investments from time to time. The Secretary or the Treasurer, on such cheques, bills, receipts, vouchers, contracts, and other and documents of whatsoever nature.

18) **MONEY RIGHTS AND DISPOSITION** :- Subject to the provisions of section 35 of the Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950 as to those of the Income Tax Act, 1961, to invest surplus funds not the Foundation not needed for immediate utilization, in authorized investments and to sell, vary or transpose such investments from time to time. No funds of the Foundation shall be invested in Shares and company deposits.

19) **ON THE OBJECTS AND OTHER FUNDS** :- The Foundation can be utilize money on following manner for

20) **ACCOUNT OPERATING**: - Society can open a bank account with a Nationalize Bank or Schedule Bank to deposit excess amount. The bank account will be run with any two joint signature of President and Secretary or Treasurer.

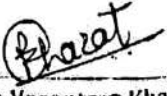
21) **LOAN AND FIXED DEPOSIT RECEIPT** :- To raise or borrow any sum or sums or money with or without interest for the purpose of the Foundation with or without security, if thought proper and secure the payment of such manner and upon such provisions of 36A of the Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950.

Subject to the provisions of section 35 of the Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950 as also to those of the Income Tax, 961, to invest surplus funds not the Foundation not needed for immediate utilization, in authorised, investments and to sell, vary or transpose such investments from time to time.

22) **IMMOVABLE PROPERTY SALE AND OTHER RELATED PROVISION**: - to acquire in the name of the Foundation by gift, purchases, exchange, lease, hire, license or otherwise however, any lands, buildings, easements or privileges for the purpose of the Foundation and to sell, assign, transfer, license, and otherwise dispose of any of the property of the Foundation. To sale the eland under Section 36 of Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950.

- 23) **AMENDMENTS TO MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION & RULES & REGULATIONS:** - In pursuance of the powers vested in it, the Governing Council may take decision to frame, amend, etc. its Rules & Regulations as may be deemed necessary or expedient for the efficient management and administration and achievement of the foundation and approved in the General Body meeting. In case of any proposal to amend the Memorandum of Association of the Foundation as regard to the enlargement of changes of changes in objects, changes in the name of the Society and amalgamation into any society, the procedures laid down in sec.12 and 12A of the Society Registration Act, 1860 shall be followed. It is further provided that amendment to the Constitution / Memorandum of Association / Bye Laws will be carried out with the approval of the competent tax authority i.e. Income tax Commissioner of Pune.
- 24) **CHANGE IN NAME AND OBJECTS:** - For the Amalgamation and change in name or object provisions of Sec. 2 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 shall be followed.
- 25) **LIST OF MEMBERS:** - The foundation shall keep in a register a list of members in which shall be recorded the name, address, occupation and signature of members Etc. every entry and alteration in the register shall be signed by the Secretary / Treasurer, with the date. The said list shall be in accordance with the section 5 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and will be maintained in the form of Schedule VI to the Societies Registration (Maharashtra) Rules, 1971 - vide Rule-13. If member of the Foundation Changed his / her address, he or she shall notify his or her new address to the President or Secretary who shall thereupon enter his / her new address in the register of Members. It will be the responsibility of the members to notify his / her changed address.
- 26) **DISSOLUTION** :- any number, not less than three fifth of the members of the Foundation entitled to hold at a meeting of the General Body Convened specially for the purpose by their votes, may determine that the Foundation shall be dissolved, whether forth with or at any future time agreed upon. However, for the dissolution on, provisions of sec. 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act, 1860 shall be followed.

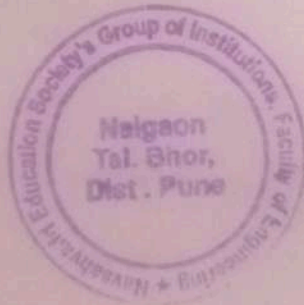
